AS A SERVANT OF JESUS CHRIST IN THE CHAMPION FELLOWSHIP WORSHIP TEAM, I COVENANT THE FOLLOWING THINGS BEFORE GOD:

**I am a believer in and active follower of Jesus Christ.**

**I am willing to commit, through Christ and to the best of my ability, to making the knowledge of and fellowship with the triune God the relentless pursuit of my life. This includes but is not limited to:**

- Consistent personal worship/prayer time
- Consistent time getting to know our God through His word
- Consistent fellowship with other believers

**I will pursue personal holiness in all areas of my life. I will do this because it is God's command (1 Peter 1:13-16, 4:1-3) and I recognize that His command is for my joy, my good (Heb 12:14) and should be my pleasure. I will put certain attitudes and actions to death and through His Spirit replace them with attitudes and actions that stir my affection for Jesus Christ. I will strive to pursue personal holiness in these areas and any others that the Spirit of God convicts me of:**

- I will refrain from any sexually immoral practice. The Bible defines sexual immorality as things such as adultery, premarital sex, homosexuality, pornography, even a lustful glance (Romans 13:11-14, 1 Corinthians 7:6:15-20,10:8, Ephesians 5:3, 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8, Hebrews 13:4, Matthew 5:27-28)

- I will refrain from any illegal drug use, drunkenness, gossip and other sinful behavior (Romans 1:28-32, 13:13, Galatians 5:19-21, Ephesians 5:18, James 3:3-18)
- I will refrain from any known attitude or behavior that might cause my Christian brother to stumble or that might hinder an unbeliever from coming to the knowledge of Jesus Christ. In the case of morally neutral things, I will choose to deprive myself of that thing rather than cause someone else to stumble by my indulgence (1 Corinthians 8:1-13).
- I will confess sin to God and fellow believers. I will be accountable with a fellow Christian of the same gender in order to give and receive encouragement in the pursuit of holiness and Jesus.

### **I will...**

- Attend every rehearsal possible, be on time, and work hard without complaining. I will do all of this **with joy** because I realize that what we are participating in is much greater than us and has eternal implications. When I serve poorly, I am serving the Lord poorly. When I serve well, I serve the Lord well and with all my heart (Matthew 25:14-30). Do all as unto the Lord! (Colossians 3:23)
- **Practice** on my own time and come as prepared as possible to rehearsal. I will seek out extra help if I need it.
- View rehearsal as an opportunity to grow in Christ with fellow believers and to worship our Savior.
- Consider others better than myself (Philippians 2:3)
- Seek to worship God the Father, Jesus the Son, and God the Holy Spirit with every aspect of my life, both on and off stage.
- *Recognize my utter dependence on Jesus Christ, and trust Him to lead worship through me.*
